

2023 LIABILITY, MEDICAL & MEDIA RELEASE FORM

In consideration for being accepted by **SpiritCHURCH** for participation in **all student** activities for 2023 (including van trips, retreats, camps, conventions, canoeing, hay rides, paint ball, ski trips, swimming, trips, and any other activities sponsored by Spirit Church), we(I), being 18 years of age or older, do for ourselves(myself) (and for and on behalf of my child-participant if said child is not 18 years of age or older) do hereby release, forever discharge and agree to hold harmless **SpiritCHURCH**, its members, officers, directors, employees, agents, representatives, successors and assigns thereof from any and all liability, claims or demands for personal injury, sickness or death, as well as property damage and expense, of any nature whatsoever which may be incurred by the undersigned and the child-participant that occur while said child is participating in the above-described trip or activity. Furthermore, we (I) [and on behalf of our (my) child-participant if under the age of 18 years] hereby assume all risk of personal injury, sickness, death, damage and expense (including attorney fees) as a result of participation in recreation and work activities involved therein. Further, authorization and permission is hereby given to said church to furnish any necessary transportation, food and lodging for this participant. The undersigned further hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify said church, its directors, employees and agents, for any liability sustained by said church as the result of the negligent, willful or intentional acts of said participant, including expenses incurred attendant thereto.

(If the participant has not attained the age of 18 years): We (I) are the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of this participant, and hereby grant our (my) permission for him (her) to participate fully in said trip, and hereby give our(my) permission to take said participant to a doctor or hospital and hereby authorize medical treatment, including but not in limitation to emergency surgery or medical treatment, and assume the responsibility of all medical bills, if any. Further, should it be necessary for the participant to return home due to medical reasons, disciplinary action or otherwise, we (I) hereby assume all transportation costs.

I agree that Spirit Church may tape or photograph my child and record his or her voice during their participation in Spirit Church activities. I agree that Spirit Church will be able to use them, in whole or in part, whether in original or modified form in any manner or media, including without limitation, for the purpose of advertising, promoting, and publicizing Spirit Church, whether during the activity or thereafter. I herby release and discharge Spirit Church and all affiliated entities from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action that I have in connection with the use and exercise of the rights granted in this release. By signing this form, I agree to all of the above and support the 10 commandments of Spirit Church trips on the backside of this page.

THE 10 COMMANDMENTS of Spirit Church Student Trips

- 1. All rules set forth by Leaders are to be obeyed at ALL times.
- 2. All behavior should be representative of Spirit Church and honoring to Jesus Christ.
- 3. All students must stay with assigned group at all times.
- 4. All medications must be approved by parents and submitted to group leaders before the trip begins.
- 5. All public displays of affection are prohibited.
- 6. Alcohol, Tobacco, Cigarettes, Drugs, drug paraphernalia, improper personal belongings, or unacceptable behavior will result in the immediate termination of the trip at the expense of the parents.
- 7. All students are only allowed in the accommodations to which they are assigned.
- 8. Vehicles, Hotel rooms, and all facilities, should be left in better condition than they were found.
- 9. Curfews and checkpoint times are very important to the safety of the group and must be obeyed.
- 10. All sign-up deadlines, money deposits, and due dates must be followed to guarantee space on any trip. Deposits are non-refundable.

These rules are given to provide the maximum safety, enjoyment, and meaning to all of students during activities and trips.

Violation of any of these rules may result in immediate trip termination at the parent's expense or confiscation of any improper personal belongings. Violations will result in forfeiture of future trips, as determined by Spirit Church Leadership.
